

First Grade EVERYDAY checklist

Required – Every school day, for a total of 5-6 hours per day.

Remember that at this age, most students can concentrate 10-20 minutes.

Break up the lessons in mini-parts and give quick moving/stretching breaks in between.

Add online and offline time spent in each subject. If no time was spent, enter 0	

- If all above is complete, then add:
 - o 1 hour of Health daily
 - o 1-2 hours for Phys Ed. per week

Options - if Core lessons are complete and you need more time

A MINIMUM of 5-6 hours of school work needs to be entered for every school day (25-30 hours per week)

Supplemental time – educational games, videos, projects – add time under the subject it best fits (up to 12 hours per week total)	

Attendance time entered must match with the lessons completed in the Online School

- No more than 10 hours of attendance time can be entered in a day
- No more than 12 hours of supplemental time per week.
- Teachers will request work samples if attendance time does not match lessons complete so that we can verify educational work (per the State of Ohio)

Communicate

- If your student misses a day of school for any reason, please let your teacher know.
- Per the State of Ohio: since our curriculum is available to students 24/7, they are not "excused" for sick days, dr. appts, vacations, etc. *You are responsible for making up any missed lessons and attendance hours.*
 - o 5-6 hours per school day = 25-30 hours per week.
