3. Extension of Virtual Meeting Resolution

Motion I: Resolution regarding Virtual Meetings

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby approves the following additions, deletions and revisions to the *Resolution regarding Board Meetings during State of Emergency* ("Virtual Meeting Resolution") that was passed on April 21, 2020:

The following additional "whereas" clauses shall be added:



WHEREAS, on November 20, 2020, the 133rd Ohio General Assembly approved H.B. 404, which pursuant to Section 12, temporarily amends the requirements that would otherwise apply under Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 regarding public meetings and extends the time frame until July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on November 23, 2020, the Ohio Governor signed H.B. 404 and declared it to be emergency legislation to be given immediate effect.

Paragraph 7 of the Virtual Meeting Resolution shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

7. The procedures used by the Board, its committees and any other entity under its jurisdiction that is a "public body" as that term is defined under Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 that have been established consistent with this resolution shall remain in effect until July 1, 2021.

Discussion: Ms. Dorner explained the recent passage of legislation that extended the ability of public bodies to hold public meetings virtually until July 1, 2021.

5. Operations

a. Approval of New Board Member

Motion II: Resolution regarding appointment of Board Member

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby appoints Patty Humbert to serve as a Board Member on the Ohio Virtual Academy Board of Trustees for a three-year term effective immediately, as recommended by the HR Committee. The Head of School shall provide the orientation materials required by Board policy.

Discussion: Mr. Vasquez explained Ms. Humbert was recommended as a candidate and proceeded through the process for Board selection. Mr. Davenport reported that the HR Committee had



interviewed Ms. Humbert and was recommending her for approval as a Board member. Ms. Lippens added that Ms. Humbert's experience in higher education and legal background will be a welcomed addition to the Board.

b. Head of School Report

Mr. Vasquez stated he requested the Head of School report to be provided at the beginning of the meeting since information in this report is often necessary to consider other Board action. Dr. Stewart presented a 6 page report indicating enrollment of 20,434 students with 13.9% special education. Currently, OHVA has 456 general education teachers, 153 intervention specialists and 146 support staff. Enrollment is on a wait list approach due to staffing shortage concerns. Student:Teacher ratios are as follows: K-5 60:1; MS 6-8 60:1; HS Core 200:1; HS Electives 220:1 and PE 350:1. State is not requiring testing however OHVA is conducting NWEA testing. Mr. Norton asked to have the results of the NWEA testing provided to the Board at the next meeting.

c. Academic Report

Dr. Stewart explained that Kyle Wilkinson will provide the academic report. Mr. Wilkinson stated that NWEA testing occurs three times a year.

i. Newrow Discussion

Mr. Wilkinson presented an 8 slide PPT review related to the history of implementing Newrow. K12 will not charge OHVA during the transition for FY21. Currently, there is no indication from K12 as to the cost related to transitioning from BlackBoard to Newrow. Mr. Vasquez expressed concerns related to the mid-year transition and its effect on students especially those new to the school as well as OHVA teachers having to once again be the guinea pigs for a new platform during this difficult pandemic year as well as transitioning to a new platform without receiving any information related to the cost of this platform. Moreover, there were reports such as from Miami-Dade school district that Newrow had serious issues during implementation. Various Board members questioned the timing of the transition and roll-out for Newrow. Ms. Dorner explained that the contract between K12 and OHVA indicates that OHVA has the discretion to determine whether to accept any other K12 additional services and Newrow would be one of those. Ms. Lopez reported BlackBoard works fine currently. Mr. Reed conveyed K12 has been working to reduce glitches and believes they have



responded to the feedback received to address basic functionality issues. Dr. Stewart responded administratively she thinks this is the right way to go and will improve student experience. Mr. Vasquez requested Mr. Shaffer to continue to perform due diligence by contacting Arkansas Virtual Academy regarding their experience with Newrow. Mr. Shaffer agreed to continue to follow up on this issue and report back to the Board at its next meeting.

d. Operations Report

Ms. Rogers reviewed a one page report concerning FTE.

i. Residency Verification Update

Ms. Rogers reviewed the residency verification process implemented by K12. Through the Verimove process, 268 addresses were verified that a forwarding address had been provided. Residency was then corrected for those addresses found incorrect during the verification process.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of OHVA Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby approves the resignations of Lacee Milliken and Amy Muehlenbauch, effective immediately to allow them to accept positions with K12, Inc. Further, the Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby waives the application of Paragraph 7.04 entitled Non-Solicitation of the Third Amended and Restated Educational Products and Administrative & Technology Services Agreement between OHVA and K12 Virtual Schools LLC to allow Lacee Milliken to be employed by K12, Inc. as an OHVA K-2 Assistant Principal and Amy Muehlenbauch as an OHVA High School Assistant Principal, exclusively for Ohio Virtual Academy. This waiver is revoked if K12 employs these individuals in a position other than the ones specifically listed.

Discussion: Due to the increased enrollment, K12 has been hiring additional administrative personnel. Two OHVA employees have sought open K12 positions at OHVA. BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby deletes the current language found under the heading of "Notification of Board Meetings" in the Board Policy Manual and replaces it with the following language:

Notification of Board Meetings

The Head of School or designee shall publish the schedule of all Board meetings including the date, time, and location on the <u>www.ohva.k12.com</u> website. This notification will be found under the heading "About Our School" and then clicking on "School Board." This notice shall also contain the following statement: "Upon request to the OHVA office, the school shall make reasonable accommodation for a disabled person to be able to participate in this activity." In addition, the Head of School or designee shall post the schedule of all Board meetings including the date, time, and location at the front of the OHVA offices with a special indication of the next Board meeting.



Notice of the time, place, and purpose of each special meeting shall be given to the news media twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the meeting, except that when an emergency requires the immediate official action of the Board, the member(s) calling the meeting or OHVA legal counsel shall immediately notify the media requesting such notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting.

Notice of meetings at which the specific type of public business is to be discussed shall be sent to all persons requesting such notice, provided that such persons supplies the Head of School with stamped, addressed envelopes for the purpose of receiving notification or a proper email address.

Discussion: Dr. Stewart indicated the OHVA website was recently updated and as a result the OHVA policy regarding notification of meeting dates, times and locations had to be updated. Ms. Dorner explained Ohio law requires the Board to have a policy regarding where a member of the public can determine the date, time and location of each public meeting.
