4. Consideration of School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Motion I: Resolution Regarding 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan (SIP)

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees of OHVA hereby approves the 2018-2019 OHVA School Improvement Plan (CCIP) (copy attached hereto) as recommended by the Senior Head of School.

Discussion: Dr. Stewart explained the Board had previously approved the Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan ("CCIP") in June 2018. This document contained OHVA's plans for school improvement. After the December Board meeting, OHVA was notified that it would need



to submit a School Improvement Plan ("SIP") by January 31, 2019 with a Board resolution. There are three reasons a school is asked to submit a SIP: (1) graduation rate is less than 67% according to DOE's method of calculating [OHVA's internal calculation shows grad rate at 83%, but DOE shows 61%]; (2) lowest 5% of the schools [OHVA is not in this group] and (3) a subgroup is under "watch" [OHVA's special education subgroup is under "watch"]. DOE would not accept the CCIP previously approved by the Board and required the same information to be put in the format designed by DOE. The plans for school improvement have not changed. Mr. Norton inquired if any additional information was needed prior to approval. Ms. Richardson sought clarification prior to the Board meeting.
