5. Operations:

a. **Head of School Report:** Dr. Stewart started the Head of School Report by discussing the OHVA current enrollment. There are currently 14,091 students enrolled at OHVA with 2,734 students (19%) being special education enrollees. OHVA has 2,674 new students enrolled. Dr. Stewart also discussed the summer reading program. There were 31 third graders who participated in the two-week intensive reading tutoring program. At the high school level, OHVA offered 1,000 high school students 39 courses for students to recover credits and get back on track or be eligible for graduation in August. Within the discussion, Mr. Vasquez asked about the current status of Intervention Specialists following the Board's approval of an incentive bonus. In response, Dr. Stewart said there are 16 new applicants; more people have accepted and are awaiting a few applicants. Dr. Stewart concluded the report with discussions about family engagement.

b. Academic Report

i. **Grants/Student Wellness and Success Funds Plan Update:** Kyle Wilkinson explained that the Student Wellness Funds assist schools, alongside community partners, to address the needs of the whole child by funding initiatives to support services for Ohio's students. OHVA's goal is to increase student wellness. As a result, OHVA has partnered with Syntero and Cornerstone of Hope. Syntero is a community-based mental health treatment provider and Cornerstone of Hope, is a nonprofit bereavement support center. Additionally, Mr. Wilkinson noted that the OHVA grade report will be provided in October.

ii.Math Seeds Purchase Requisition (motion)

Motion II: Mathseeds Purchase Requisition

WHEREAS, Mathseeds is a research-based, online mathematics program offering interactive lessons, assessments, and individualized learning pathways aligned with state standards; the program has



demonstrated effectiveness in improving foundational math skills, increasing student engagement, and supporting differentiated instruction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of OHVA approves the purchase of Mathseeds for the 2025-2026 academic year, at a total cost not to exceed \$22,000 as recommended by the Head of School.

c. **Special Programs Report:** Johna McClure, Special Program Director provided an overview of the statistics regarding the special education enrollees. Additionally, Ms. McClure shared that a “Back to School Picnic” is set for September 5th from 11-1 P.M. at Side Cut Park in Maumee and Walbridge in Toledo.

d. Operations Report

i. **Residency Verification Update:** Emily Rogers, Senior Operations Manager explained how at the outset of the school year, OHVA experienced enrollment issues. There are about 311 students whose statuses are unknown. Ms. Rogers also explained the re-registrations process.

6. **Finance:** Dawn Cummings, Treasurer reported that the average enrollment was 16,892 students. Revenue increased due to enrollment, combined with new allocation amounts for federal funds, and new updates to the state funding formula. Teacher expenses increased due to the removal of delayed hiring impact, which increases salaries assuming OHVA will be fully staffed. Student & Family Services increased due to enrollment and increased school event expenses covered by parent and student funds. Administration and Governance/Technology increased along with revenue. Insurance/Facilities/Other decreased due to aligning costs to prior year end totals. Within this discussion, Matt Norton



asked about bank account type and interest available. Ms. Cummings explained that options for increased interest are limited for public entities such as OHVA.

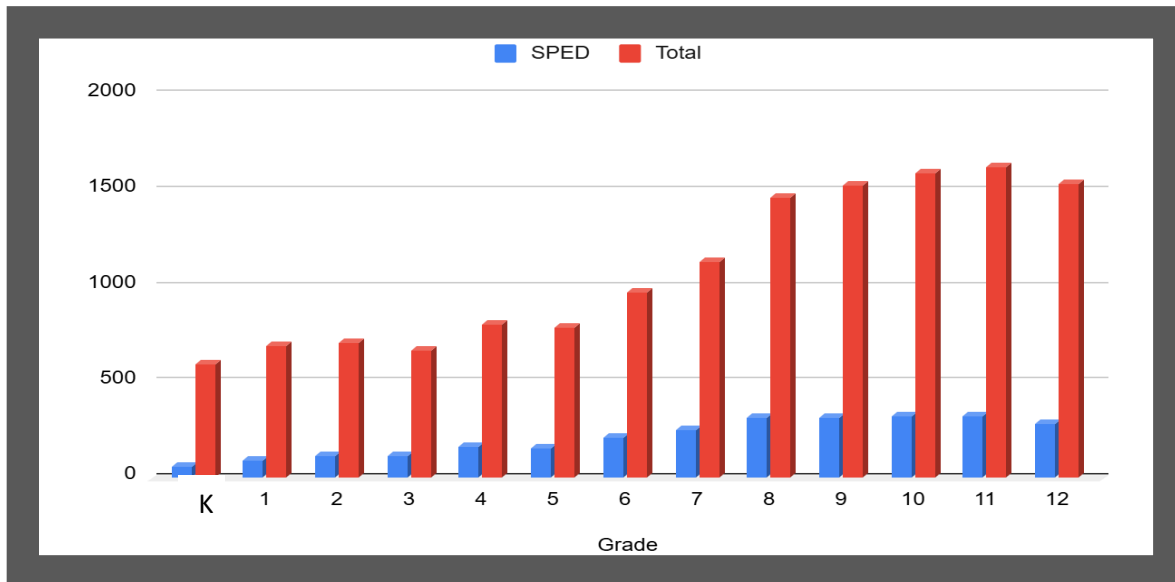

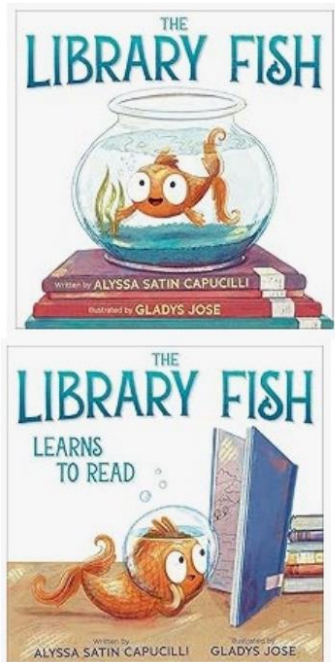

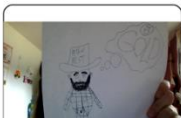
